KICKOFF COVERAGE

- Owatonna is 2-0 all-time against Chanhassen, beating the Storm 36-21 in 2011 and 21-14 in 2012.
- After rushing for nearly 1,500 yards and 18 touchdowns last season, Chanhassen tailback Maxwell Woods was selected to the KARE 11 Preseason All-Metro team. He needed just 12 carries to gain 109 yards against Elk River last week.
- Though the Storm have never made it to state, the program has just three losing seasons in 12 years as a program. Chanhassen plays in an ultra-competitive Section 2-AAAAA and is consistently ranked with the state's top 10 for Class AAAAA.
- Last year, the Storm finished 8-2, losing to state-ranked Robbinsdale Armstrong, 34-29, during the regular season and 23-21 to Mankato West in the section championship game.
- Chanhassen was 5-0 at home last season and has not lost on its home turf since being upset by Waconia, 22-12, in the Section 2-AAAAA semifinals on Tuesday, Oct. 26, 2021.
- The Storm picked up an impressive comeback win over defending Class AAAAA state champion, Elk River, in Week 1. The Storm scored two touchdowns in the game's final 9:34 to pull off the victory on the road.
