THE HART OF THE CADETS

St. Thomas Academy running back, Savion Hart, is one of the most dynamic big school running backs since Jason Williamson. Through 10 games, he's racked up 2,031 total yards (1,918 rushing) and 30 touchdowns (29 rushing). He's a high school track and field All-American and his 40-yard dash time has been clocked at 4.45 seconds.

COACHING CREDENTIALS

When looking to fill its vacant head coaching position this past offseason, St. Thomas Academy once again looked to the next level and hired long-time college assistant, Travis Walch. After a wildly successful playing career at Division II Winona State University, Walch spent 20-plus years as a college assistant at all three levels of the NCAA, most recently at the University of St. Thomas. He replaced Dan O'Brien, who once spent time on the staff at the University of Minnesota. This past offseason, O'Brien left to take the head coaching position at Holy Family Catholic.

OFFENSE, OFFENSE & MORE OFFENSE

The Cadets boast a prolific offense and have scored no fewer than four TDs in any single game this season. Operating out of a Wing-T formation, STA averages exactly 400 yards per game, nearly 70% of which has come on the ground. However, the Cadets are just as dangerous through the air, amassing 1,213 passing yards and 14 TDs.
