HIGH-STAKES SHOWDOWN

The Huskies and Rockets both enter the contest 3-0 against district and sectional opponents and can secure the No. 1 seed in the Section 1-5A bracket and a Northstar District South-Maroon title with a victory.

ROCKETS ASCENDING

Under the guidance of Kyle Riggot, John Marshall has risen from 0-9 in 2022, to 4-6 in 2023 to 5-1 through six weeks this season. Last year, the Rockets won their first postseason game since 2019 and has already secured a top two seed in the forthcoming Section 1-5A bracket.

OLD SCHOOL IRON MAN

Though two-way players are commonplace at the Class 5A level, few are asked to start at both middle linebacker and tailback like the Rockets' TyShawn Beane. The staff has managed the situation well and kept their two-way star fresh by limiting his offensive touches to roughly 12 per game. He leads the team with 550 rushing yards.

A DANGEROUS DOUBLE-THREAT

Savy Vath has emerged as a true dual-threat quarterback for the Rockets and is coming off a career performance against Rochester Century in which he accounted for six touchdowns in John Marshall's 41-0 victory. Entering Week 7, he has rung up 15 passing touchdowns and added another five TDs on the ground. Vath averages more than 220 yards of total offense per game and is tops amongst all John Marshall rushers at 7.5 YPC.

SAME CITY, NEW TEAM

Senior twin brothers Denard and Markes Simpson transferred to John Marshall from cross-town rival Century and have made a huge impact on the Rockets. Not counting Week 6 -- which have not been logged yet -- the pair have accounted for 398 receiving yards and eight touchdowns.
