OWATONNA KEYS TO THE GAME



- CONTAIN THE QUARTERBACK**
John Marshall quarterback, Savy Vath, has thrown for 21 touchdowns this season, but is even more dangerous with his legs. Against OHS during the regular season, Vath burned the Huskies for 85 rushing yards and one touchdown on just seven carries.
- TAKE CARE OF THE BALL**
When it comes to turnovers, OHS has played with fire all season and was nearly burned last week against New Prague in a shaky 14-7 victory that saw Hunter Theis throw three interceptions. Against the Rockets, the margin for error is razor thin and the Huskies must win the TO battle.
- START STRONG, STAY STRONG**
This is the biggest contest for the John Marshall program since it last played in the Section 1-5A championship game in 2015. The 2024 Rockets have also made it no secret about how excited they are to play the Huskies, so jumping on them early will go a long way in deciding the outcome of this do-or-die showdown.

ROCKETS HEATING UP

In its last two contests since losing to Owatonna, 32-22, in Week 7, Rochester John Marshall has produced its two highest-scoring outputs of the season, blowing out Jefferson, 53-21, in Week 8 and routing Northfield, 47-27, in the section semifinals. The Rockets are averaging 47 points in their last three wins.

TRISTAN 'GREASE LIGHTNING' GRAHAM

Known for his ability to slip out of tackles (grease) and slice through cutback lanes on a dime (lightning), OHS tailback, Tristan Graham, has racked up 303 rushing yards and three touchdowns in his last two games. In the section semifinals, he posted his first career 200-yard outing and scored the game-winning TD with 58 second on the clock.
