1 REMAIN DISCIPLINED ON DEFENSE


New Prague's option-style, run-heavy operation has caused Owatonna fits in the past and requires all three levels of the defense to remain focused and technically-sound. The front seven is responsible for clogging up the running lanes while the secondary cannot take a play off as the Trojans have been known to deploy an ultra-effective play-action passing attack.

2 TAKE ADVANTAGE ON OFFENSE

Due to the Trojans clock-chewing style, Owatonna's offensive opportunities will be limited. New Prague has been known to sap upwards of 10 minutes off the clock on a single possession. The Huskies will be in for a long evening if they lose the turnover battle and/or fail to execute in the red zone.

3 BE A GOLDFISH

Yes, it has been a rough start for the Huskies on both sides of the ball, but every new game provides a clean slate and a fresh opportunity to get back on track. It's easier said than done, but Owatonna must put its struggles behind them and build momentum as the second half of the season gets underway.
